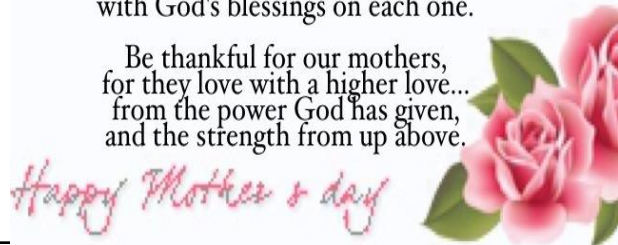
There is no love, like a mother's love
